Introduction to Traffic Calming and Manual for Streets

Course Overview

This two-day course is designed to give an introduction to the essential elements of Traffic Calming and to the principles of design using Manual for Streets. After attending, delegates should have more confidence to design a wide range of traffic calming and public realm schemes, and understand many of the benefits and pitfalls associated with these schemes. The course consists of informal short lectures, practical workshops and case studies.

This course is aimed at a broad range of professionals interested in the fundamentals of both Traffic Calming and Manual for Streets and public realm.

Aims and Objectives

The aim of the course is to help delegates to understand the issues involved in designing, building and monitoring the effects of traffic calming schemes and to provide delegates with the knowledge, skills and understanding to carry out their professional roles.

The course provides the opportunity for delegates to network and consider alternative methods of traffic calming and to provide advice on delegates' own traffic calming project needs and improve their design and implementation skills.

- Carriageway geometry MfS compared to DMRB (inc workshop)
